



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


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**Big Idea 1: (Remember, answers may vary):** The English king borrowed money from William's father. After his father died, William asked the King for land in America to repay the money owed to his father.

- 1755: started a hospital
- 1776: helped write the Declaration of Independence
- 1777: got French king to help America during the American Revolution
- 1787: helped write the U.S. Constitution plan of government
- 1790: Ben Franklin died.


